

Interval Chart

On the interval chart there is a need to explain some of the symbols.

-2	= minor second, or $\frac{1}{2}$ step
M2	= Major second, or a whole step
-3	= minor third, or $3 - \frac{1}{2}$ steps
M3	= Major third, or $4 - \frac{1}{2}$ steps
P4	= Perfect fourth, or $5 - \frac{1}{2}$ steps
#4/b5	= Tritone, or $6 - \frac{1}{2}$ steps
P5	= Perfect fifth, or $7 - \frac{1}{2}$ steps
#5/b6	= minor sixth (aug 5), or $8 - \frac{1}{2}$ steps
M6	= Major sixth, or $9 - \frac{1}{2}$ steps
b7	= minor seventh (dom7), or $10 - \frac{1}{2}$ steps
M7	= Major seventh, or $11 - \frac{1}{2}$ steps
8va	= octave, or $12 - \frac{1}{2}$ steps
