

ZERO TOLERANCE CONTRACT

Discipline Code

The Governing Board of Penguin Records and the Rio Linda High School Music Department has adopted a policy of ZERO TOLERANCE on the possession of loaded or unloaded firearms, knives, explosive devices, or any other dangerous weapons, the possession, sale or being under the influence of a controlled substance or alcohol, commits or attempts to commit robbery or extortion, or when a student causes, attempts to cause or threatens to cause serious physical injury to another person.

Hereafter, any student who is found in possession of loaded or unloaded firearms, knives, explosive devices, or any other dangerous weapons, has possession, sells or is under the influence of any controlled substance or alcohol, commits or attempts to commit robbery or extortion, or causes, attempts to cause serious physical injury to another person, he/he shall be immediately suspended and recommended for expulsion, unless the particular circumstances of the case indicate that expulsion is inappropriate. No exception shall be made in the case of the possession of a loaded or unloaded firearm.

We would also like to reinforce our district's philosophy that in order to provide each student with a quality education, we, in collaboration with parents/guardians, students, and staff, expect each student to make a strong commitment to high expectations of achievement. In that light, we the undersigned, support the fundamental concept which includes the following:

- An emphasis on early mastery of the basic subjects
- A strong commitment to academic achievement
- Exemplary student effort
- A dedication to excellence
- Courteous and orderly behavior
- Greater homework requirements
- Exemplary attendance
- Parental support of school rules, policies and the educational program; and
- Strict adherence to all discipline policies (including but not limited to NO smoking, drugs, weapons, battery, alcohol or paraphernalia).

We understand that a student enrolled in the advanced guitar class, known as Penguin Records, is expected to work rigorously to achieve his/her highest level. Violation of the ZERO TOLERANCE policy with regards to drugs, alcohol, weapons, or battery will result in a recommendation for expulsion. The Grant Joint Union High School District Administrative Panel will conduct the expulsion hearing.

I have read and understand the district's policy on ZERO TOLERANCE. I have also read and understand the school's discipline policy. To assist in the learning and success of my student in school, I will do the following:

- Monitor my student's progress (weekly)
- Clear excused absences quickly
- Support the high school's attendance policy
- Support the high school's discipline policy

I will also encourage my student to:

- Have excellent attendance and be prompt to all classes
- Follow all school rules and regulations
- Treat all school personnel with respect
